

Pleasure and culture

Burgundy is about sharing conviviality, between gastronomy and good wines, between rolling countryside and old abbeys with glazed tiles, castles...

It is also the calm, the nature, a space of relaxation where it is good to walk the time of an escapade at a few hours of Paris.



In Tournus, the Hotel dieu was built in the 17th and 19th centuries, classified as a historical monument, it has preserved all its old rooms (three sick rooms and two chapels), fitted out with their original furniture; closed wooden beds, china cabinet, pewter, earthenware, it also houses a rich apothecary, Nevers and Dijon earthenware, blown glass bottles. A wing of the Hôtel-Dieu is home to the Greuze museum.

Saint Philibert Abbey, built by the monks fleeing Noirmoutier in front of the Norman invader, to house the relics of their holy founder Philibert, the abbey of Tournus is one of the most prestigious sanctuaries of the first Romanesque art.

The castle of Brancion, in the heart of the Romanesque road that links the abbeys of Tournus and Cluny, perched on a rocky spur, Brancion welcomes you and takes you to discover a dreamlike Middle Ages, fortified gate, keep overlooking the village and the Romanesque church, exceptional panoramas and strolls in an entirely pedestrian site. Surrounded by greenery, the castle is a place where time seems to have stopped.



Between Tournus and Cluny, in the heart of southern Burgundy, the Château de Cormatin awaits you in the middle of its gardens and water features. The Marquis d'Huxelles had it built at the beginning of the XVIIth century to testify to their power and prestige; wide moats, turrets, high base with bosses, gunboats and drawbridge, the castle was made to impress, it still succeeds today.

The Abbey of Cluny: William the Pious founded the abbey in 910, directly under the protection of Rome. Its abbot enjoys a role of mediator between the political powers and the pope. Cluny is the mother house of 1400 outbuildings, sold as national property in 1798, the abbey is dismantled, and its church, almost destroyed.

Along the water, sail on the Saone and the Seille...take a 1h30 trip or spend a few days sailing on the Saone and the Seille...enjoy the scenery and let yourself be carried away.

#### ACTIVITIES

The Burgundy wine tourist route extends its territory between the Auxerrois and the Maconnais. Its vineyards cover nearly 29500 hectares and benefit from 84 AOCs, from the regional appellation to the Burgundian Grands Crus, mainly made from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.



The Yonne vineyard road, as its name suggests, criss-crosses the department of Yonne. One of the kings wines of this route is Chablis. As far as visits are concerned, the traveller is spoiled here; Auxerre, Tonnerre, Vézelay.

The road of the great vintages of Burgundy is considered a royal road. It crosses the part of the Cote d'Or where the most prestigious vineyards are located. After visiting Dijon, drive along the famous Côte de Nuits through the villages of Marsannay, Gevrey Chambertin and Nuits Saint Georges. Then continue on the Côte de Beaune, with a stop at the famous Hospices, and wander through the vineyards of Pommard, Volnay, Meursault...



The «Route des Grands Vins» extends the «Route des Grands Crus» from Santenay to Saint Gengoux le National, it makes you discover the Côte Chalonnaise by passing from one charming village to another; vineyards, hedged farmland, Romanesque churches, castles, canal du Centre.

### The archipelago of Burgundy wines has 4 major tourist routes





The Maconnais-Beaujolais wine route takes you to the Saone et Loire: It is from there that come the wines of Macon, Pouilly, Saint Véran, Passetoutgrain, Viré Clessé, when you reach the Rhone, you arrive on the territory of the Beaujolais (Saint Amour, Julienas, Chenas, Moulin à Vent, Fleurie, Chrioubles, Morgon, Regnié, Cote de Brouilly, Brouilly). ) The geographical location of Tournus, a gastronomic city halfway between north and south, allows you to spend an exotic weekend three hours from Paris, or to make a stopover on the road to the winter sports resorts or the Mediterranean.



Situated on the banks of the Saone, Tournus is the highlight of the South Burgundy wine route, at the crossroads of the vineyards of the Chalonnais and the Maconnais, an ideal place to discover the Burgundian heritage during a leisure or business stay.

### ACCES AND TRANSPORTS

#### PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Access to Tournus train station at 5 minutes walking distance, direct line from Lyon and Dijon. TGV station in Macon Loché or Montchanin le Creusot (15 minutes by TER or car).

CAR

Motorway A6, exit 27 Tournus (3 minutes from the Hotel) At one hour driving from Dijon and Lyon.

### PARKING

**Underground paying car park** with a capacity of 40 spaces (reservation in advance) equipped with 10 electric charging stations.

Free secure outdoor car park with a capacity of 25 parking spaces and 4 electric charging stations.
